ORGANIC (ORG)

Organic Wine is made with no added synthetic pesticides, herbicides or any other chemicals like artificial fertilisers. The wines are accredited by the country's relevant organisation such as The Soil Association of Britain. Many more producers operate to "organic principles" but may be too small or too stubborn to go through the rigorous certification process.

VEGETARIAN (V)

It may seem that a beverage made from pressed and fermented grapes should be vegetarian, but animal derivatives can be used in the fining process, such as Isinglass for example.

VEGAN (VE)

Vegan wines don't contain fining or clarifying agents (like egg white or Casein).

SUSTAINABLY PRODUCED (SP)

Sustainable Winegrowing is a comprehensive set of practices that are environmentally sound, socially equitable and economically viable. They work to conserve energy, maintain healthy soil, protect air and water quality, enhance relations with communities, preserve ecosystems and improve the vitality of vineyards and wineries. Different wine regions have different challenges and each country has their own certifying body.

CHAMPAGNE LIST

Champagne Ayala has been specially selected as the House Champagne of Brend Hotels. It is owned by the Bollinger family and is one of the longest established champagne houses, based in the town of Ay since it was founded in 1860. Ayala Champagne was first awarded the Royal Warrant by Edward VIII in 1908 and for over a century Ayala has been the house Champagne of many a British institution.

01. AYALA BRUT MAJEUR (SP)

France, Champagne

Light gold in colour, with a delicate mousse. The nose unveils expressive notes of citrus and white fruits. Ayala has been owned by Bollinger since 2005 and has grown up to be the chic little sister. The style is one of modernity exemplified by their grower relationships and the use of stainless steel in the production of their Chardonnay Led style. Also one of the only houses to have a female Chef de Cave - Caroline Latrive.

02. AYALA ROSE MAJEUR (SP)

France, Champagne

Delicate and tangy, light, frothy mousse. Ayala is one of the only large houses to produce a Chardonnay dominated Rose. This wine therefore displays characteristics of grapefruit and blood orange with a lip smackingly dry finish.

04. BOLLINGER NV (SP)

France, Champagne

Bollinger is one of the oldest family houses still in existence in Champagne, steeped in history and tradition. Methods have little changed and their wines are truly outstanding. Pinot Noir is the backbone of this house, giving richer flavours, further enhanced by their unique use of cask.

06. DOM PERIGNON 2012 (V) (SP)

Bright floral notes give way to candied fruit, herbaceousness and finally hints of liquorice. Confidently mineral and persistent, this is a classic accompaniment to a stylish celebration. enhanced by their unique use of cask.

Côtes Du Roussillon, France

16. LA JOYA CHARDONNAY GRAN RESERVA 2022 (V) (SP)

Chile, Colchagua

La Joya, meaning 'the jewel,' is the flagship wine of this boutique, family-owned vineyard. The wine is full of smooth mineral notes, bright citrus aromas of grapefruit, lime and orange peel. Long and mouth watering finish.

17. GABBIANO PINOT GRIGIO 2022 (SP)

Italy, Veneto

Floral notes caress the nose, with nuances of pear and honeydew melon. Citrus flavours are evident on the palate, alongside crunchy green apple and pear. This wine finds an excellent harmony of fruit and acid, with a slightly nutty almond finish.

Germany, Rheinhessen

A sweeter option with notes of apricot, fleshy peach and pear.

19. THE CROSSINGS SAUVIGNON BLANC 2022 (V) (SP)

New Zealand, Marlborough

This wine shows lifted notes of gooseberry and passion fruit, under pinned with citrus zing. The palate is full with pure fruit flavours, yet balanced with a persistent, crisp mineral finish.

France, Burgundy

France, Loire Valley

22. M. CHAPOUTIER SCHIEFERKOPF RIESLING 2022 (SP)

Germany, Baden

A fruity and floral to the nose, citrus, mirabelle and orange blossom all shine through. The palate has a taut, mineral structure, lovely roundness and is fresh with a very long finish.

23. LANGLOIS CHATEAU MUSCADET SEVRE ET MAINE SUR LIE 2021 (SP)

France, Loire Valley

Delicate aromas of stone and citrus fruit with a palate of everything you would want from a Muscadet of this quality; fresh, fruity, bone dry with a salty tang on the finish.

24. LA LANCELOTTA GAVI 2023 (V) (SP)

Italy, Piemonte

Zesty citrus fruit and lightly floral characters, with hints of apple and pear. Fresh, steely acidity and underlying mineral characters, balanced by notes of melon and stone fruit, and a touch of fennel and spice.

28. DOMAINE CHANSON MEURSAULT 2022 (V) (SP)

France, Burgundy

Floral fragrances of acacia mixed with refreshing citrus fruit. Tight and precise texture with hazelnut and vanilla on the finish long and mineral finish.

29. KEN FORRESTER CHENIN BLANC RESERVE 2022

South Africa, Stellenbosch/Somerset West
Mr Chenin! Ken Forrester is an icon of the wine world
whit it comes to the humble championing Chenin
Blanc! This is a great example, full bodied and
well-rounded with a complex structure. Bursting with
flavours of dried apricots and hints of vanilla and
honey that last long on the finish.

CONTEMPORARY WHITE WINES

30. YOU & ME ALBARINO 2021 (V) (SP)

Spain, Rias Baixas

This fabulous Albarino comes from the most northern and coolest subzone of Rias Baixas. A truly refreshing Albarino oozing with flavour, from apricot and banana to acacia honey with a tantalising mineral finish.

31. LA FONT FRANÇAISE PICPOUL DE PINET 2023

France, Languedoc

Beautiful bright colour with green highlights, an intense nose of white fleshed fruit. The wine is well balanced and leaves a fresh canvas upon the palate. Accompanies seafood, oysters and grilled fish dishes.

32. M. CHAPOUTIER VIOGNIER 2021 (SP) (ORG)

France, Languedoc

Golden in colour with textbook viognier notes of apricots, pear and marmalade. Exotic, Complex and perfumed, with lively, clean, dry style on the finish. This blending of roundness and freshness is characteristic of viognier from the volcanic soils.

35. CLOS DU BOIS CHARDONNAY 2020 (SP)

USA, California

A refreshingly aromatic wine from the rugged coast of California. Scents of warm apple pastry rise from the glass with touches of honey and toasted oak. Bright layers of freshly sliced pear and ripe apple with zests of citrus carry through the long finish.

38. KLEIN CONSTANTIA METIS SAUVIGNON BLANC 2018 (SP)

South Africa, Constantia

Inspired by the time Matt Day (winemaker) spent in the Loire Valley, this is a naturally fermented Sauvignon Blanc made with minimal sulphur dioxide. Savoury, wild and leesy with fresh citrus aromas.

The wine has a round and expressive palate, full and grippy with a zesty acidity. It finishes with a long burst of mineral and lime flavours and a Sancerre-like tang.

41. RAWSONS RETREAT CHARDONNAY SEMILLON 0.5% (SP) LOW ALCOHOL

Australia, South East

Sourced from carefully selected fruit parcels, this low alcohol Semillon Chardonnay is crisp and vibrant. Fresh tropical and citrus fruit flavours spread across the mid palate. Melons, lemons and limes are easily detected followed by crisp rounded acidity and a slight tartness.

Spain, La Mancha

43. LA JOYA CABERNET SAUVIGNON GRAN RESERVA 2020 (V) (SP)

Chile, Colchagua

France, Rhône Valley

Crimson in colour with a complex nose of blackcurrant and plum followed by roasted coffee and cinnamon, red cherry and Morello cherry. A spicy palate with liquorice, pepper and clove.

45. M. CHAPOUTIER CROZES-HERMITAGE, LES MEYSONNIERS 2021 (SP) (ORG)

France, Rhône Valley

The nose bursts with blackcurrant and raspberry, followed by violet aromas. Ample and round in the mouth, finishing on flavours of sumptuous stewed fruits and vanilla.

46. KOONUNGA HILL PENFOLDS 'SEVENTY SIX' SHIRAZ CABERNET 2021 (SP)

Australia, Eden Valley

Spicy and fruit driven, with a medley of blackcurrant and black fruit cascading onto the palate. There is sweet vanilla spice and cedar oak adding complexity. **BOTTLE £45**

47.GABBIANO CHIANTI CLASSICO RISERVA 2018 (SP)

Italy, Tuscany

Created from the estates oldest vineyards, this Riserva Chianti Classico keeps the most typical characteristics of this old tradition wine emphasized by a balanced ageing in wood.

48. THE CROSSINGS PINOT NOIR 2021 (V) (SP)

New Zealand, Marlborough

This expressive Pinot Noir has lifted aromas of black plums and violets. Ripe berry fruit flavours combine with savoury notes on the palate to produce a wine that is both elegant and approachable.

France, Bordeaux

51. LE QUARTIER DU CRU BEAUJOLAIS FLEURIE 2021

France, Burgundy

Light to medium bodied with an abundance of dried rose petals on the nose followed by supple dried cherry fruit and fig notes.

53. FONTANAFREDDA BAROLO DI SERRALUNGA D'ALBA 2019 (v)

Italy, Piemonte

Classic dark tar and perfumed roses on the nose, light in colour but with great power, concentration and well balanced ripe tannins. This is a wine to match with rich foods and game dishes.

54. KEN FORRESTER MERLOT RESERVE 2019

South Africa, Stellenbosch

This Reserve Merlot is rich and smoky with hints of cherries and mint. Softly rounded wine with balanced tannins.

57. TRIVENTO RESERVE MALBEC 2021

Argentina, Mendoza

A bright carmine red wine. Plum and raspberry jam aromas mingle elegantly with vanilla notes. Well balanced with sweet tannins and a velvety finish.

Spain, Rioja

Aromas of ripe fruit, balsamic, vanilla and tobacco. Medium in structure and rounded on the palate.

60. BODEGAS RODA SELA 2019 (VG) (SP)

Spain, Rioja

Made from bush vines 15-30 years old which are low yielding but produce quality concentrated fruit. The nose is bursting with aromas of cherries, redcurrants and blackberries. The palate is elegant with lively, fresh flavours. An entire year in semi-new French oak rounds the wine out to perfection.

61. KLEIN CONSTANTIA ESTATE RED 2019 (SP)

South Africa, Constantia

Intense red and black fruit with notes of cinnamon spice on the nose. Full bodied and savoury with a well-integrated oak component, ending with a long and rich finish. The blend is dominated by king of the red grapes-Cabernet and further enhanced with Shiraz, Malbec and Petit Verdot.

62. RAWSONS RETREAT CABERNET 0.5% (SP) LOW ALCOHOL

Australia, South East

Deep flavours of raspberry and blackcurrant with a slight tartness, followed by layers of sweet spice like cinnamon and clove.

63. FINCA FLICHMAN DEDICADO TUPUNGATO MALBEC 2019 (V) (SP)

Argentina, Mendoza

Made from the best hand-harvested fruit from the high altitude Tupungato vineyards in the Valle de Uco, giving the wine a balance of elegance and intensity. It bursts with aromas of ripe red fruits, plums and redcurrants, along with integrated oak influences. It shows good concentration, and has a complex and wonderfully persistent finish.

64. KALI HART PINOT NOIR 2018 (SP)

USA, California

Delightful and intriguing nose with spices, cedar oak, red fruits and hints of herbs. Characterful palate with strawberry, rhubarb and mushroom.

USA, California

Italy, Sicily

It is produced from the indigenous varieties Nero d'Avola and Frappato. A unique wine, recognisable and unforgettable for its youthful flavours and aromas of cherry and strawberry.
