ORGANIC (ORG)

Organic Wine is made with no added synthetic pesticides, herbicides or any other chemicals like artificial fertilisers. The wines are accredited by the country's relevant organisation such as The Soil Association of Britain. Many more producers operate to "organic principles" but may be too small or too stubborn to go through the rigorous certification process.

VEGETARIAN (V)

It may seem that a beverage made from pressed and fermented grapes should be vegetarian, but animal derivatives can be used in the fining process, such as Isinglass for example.

VEGAN (VE)

Vegan wines don't contain fining or clarifying agents (like egg white or Casein).

SUSTAINABLY PRODUCED (SP)

Sustainable Winegrowing is a comprehensive set of practices that are environmentally sound, socially equitable and economically viable. They work to conserve energy, maintain healthy soil, protect air and water quality, enhance relations with communities, preserve ecosystems and improve the vitality of vineyards and wineries. Different wine regions have different challenges and each country has their own certifying body.

CHAMPAGNE LIST

Champagne Ayala has been specially selected as the House Champagne of Brend Hotels. It is owned by the Bollinger family and is one of the longest established champagne houses, based in the town of Ay since it was founded in 1860. Ayala Champagne was first awarded the Royal Warrant by Edward VIII in 1908 and for over a century Ayala has been the house Champagne of many a British institution.

01. AYALA BRUT MAJEUR (SP)

£80

France, Champagne. Light gold in colour, with a delicate mousse. The nose unveils expressive notes of citrus and white fruits. Ayala has been owned by Bollinger since 2005 and has grown up to be the chic little sister. The style is one of modernity exemplified by their grower relationships and the use of stainless steel in the production of their Chardonnay Led style. Also one of the only houses to have a female Chef de Cave - Caroline Latrive.

02. AYALA ROSE MAJEUR (SP)

£95

France, Champagne. Delicate and tangy, light, frothy mousse. Ayala is one of the only large houses to produce a Chardonnay dominated Rose. This wine therefore displays characteristics of grapefruit and blood orange with a lip smackingly dry finish.

04. BOLLINGER NV (SP)

£105

France, Champagne. Bollinger is one of the oldest family houses still in existence in Champagne, steeped in history and tradition. Methods have little changed and their wines are truly outstanding. Pinot Noir is the backbone of this house, giving richer flavours, further enhanced by their unique use of cask.

06. DOM PERIGNON 2012 (VE) (SP)

France, Champagne. Bright floral notes give way to candied fruit, herbaceousness and finally hints of liquorice. Confidently mineral and persistent, this is a classic accompaniment to a stylish celebration. enhanced by their unique use of cask.

Central Valley, Chile

A fruity and lively palate followed by a voluminous but well-balanced mid-palate offering notes of white flowers and lichees with a citrus finish.

France, Burgundy

Pale gold colour. Delicate floral fragrances (hawthorn) mixed with aromas of citrus fruit on a subtle minerality. Pure and well-crafted. Very pure fruit combination.

21. HUBERT BROCHARD SANCERRE 2024 (VE)

France, Loire Valley

A classic Sancerre from the family owned Domaine Hubert Brochard. Aromas of white flowers, Citrus and exotic fruits. Balanced, Fresh and a perfect accompaniment to seafood and grilled fish dishes.

24. LA LANCELOTTA GAVI 2024 (VE) (SP)

Italy, Piemonte

Zesty citrus fruit and lightly floral characters, with hints of apple and pear. Fresh, steely acidity and underlying mineral characters, balanced by notes of melon and stone fruit, and a touch of fennel and spice.

28. DOMAINE CHANSON MEURSAULT 2022 (VE) (SP)

France, Burgundy

Floral fragrances of acacia mixed with refreshing citrus fruit. Tight and precise texture with hazelnut and vanilla on the finish long and mineral finish.

29. FRYER'S COVE CHENIN BLANC 2024 (VE)

South Africa, Cape West Coast

This Chenin Blanc is bright with acidity that supports mouthwatering flavours of lemon, nectarine and white peach. The lingering minerality provides a vibrant and satisfying finish, with subtle oak spice from maturation in large oak barrels.

30. YOU & ME ALBARINO 2024 (VE) (SP)

Spain, Rias Baixas

This fabulous Albarino comes from the most northern and coolest subzone of Rias Baixas. A truly refreshing Albarino oozing with flavour, from apricot and banana to acacia honey with a tantalising mineral finish.

31. LA FONT FRANCAISE PICPOUL DE PINET 2024

France, Languedoc

Beautiful bright colour with green highlights, an intense nose of white fleshed fruit. The wine is well balanced and leaves a fresh canvas upon the palate. Accompanies seafood, oysters and grilled fish dishes.

32. M. CHAPOUTIER VIOGNIER 2023 (SP) (ORG)

France, Languedoc

Golden in colour with textbook viognier notes of apricots, pear and marmalade. Exotic, Complex and perfumed, with lively, clean, dry style on the finish. This blending of roundness and freshness is characteristic of viognier from the volcanic soils.

35. CLOS DU BOIS CHARDONNAY 2022 (SP)

USA, California

A refreshingly aromatic wine from the rugged coast of California. Scents of warm apple pastry rise from the glass with touches of honey and toasted oak. Bright layers of freshly sliced pear and ripe apple with zests of citrus carry through the long finish.

Australia, McLaren Vale

Light to medium bodied with hints of peach, melon and butterscotch.

France, Rhône Valley

Crimson in colour with a complex nose of blackcurrant and plum followed by roasted coffee and cinnamon, red cherry and Morello cherry. A spicy palate with liquorice, pepper and clove.

45. M. CHAPOUTIER CROZES-HERMITAGE, LES MEYSONNIERS 2023 (SP) (ORG)

France, Rhône Valley

The nose bursts with blackcurrant and raspberry, followed by violet aromas. Ample and round in the mouth, finishing on flavours of sumptuous stewed fruits and vanilla.

46. KOONUNGA HILL PENFOLDS 'SEVENTY SIX' SHIRAZ CABERNET 2021 (SP)

Australia, Eden Valley

Spicy and fruit driven, with a medley of blackcurrant and black fruit cascading onto the palate. There is sweet vanilla spice and cedar oak adding complexity.

47. CONTESSA DI RADDA CHIANTI CLASSICO RISERVA 2019 (VE)

Italy, Tuscany

A Chianti riserva that delivers powerful fruit, backed with delicious spicy oak firm but fine tannins and a rounded finish. A Good accompaniment to red meat and pasta dishes.

48. RONGOPAI PINOT NOIR 2022 (SP)

New Zealand, Marlborough

Light to medium bodied with strawberry and spice aromas accompanied by dark cherry and earthy notes. Elegant with juicy red fruits lingering on the finish.

49. MOUTON CADET RES GRAVES ROUGE 2018 (SP)

France, Bordeaux

From the highly acclaimed Rothschild Estate, Mouton Cadet Rouge is a perfect wine to drink with roast red meats and chargrilled steaks. Flavours of ripe black fruits, Christmas spice, prominent tannins and rich complexity.

50. BLASON DE L'EVANGILE POMEROL 2020 (SP)

France, Bordeaux

Barons de Rothschild (Lafite)'s vineyards with the same care and attention as the Grand Vins but made from the younger vines. This allows for a fresher, and less aged style of classic top notch Bordeaux.

51. FLEURIE LA MADONE 2024 (VE)

France, Burgundy

Light to medium bodied with a heady perfume of freshly picked irises and peonies drift above the crushed berry fruit note. Rip tannins and fresh acidity support a palate of cherries and strawberries with a wonderfully elegant finish.

57. PRINCIPATO PINOT NOIR 2023

Italy, Lombardia

Nice fresh and sustained colour, the nose is very present with notes of red fruits and blackberries with a small hint of laurel, the mouth is pure red fruits enhanced by notes of liquorice, roasted almonds and mocha, with light tannins.

Unoaked, youthful and vibrant Malbec. Purple red in colour, bright and intense with fresh, fruity aromas of plum and cherry.

60. BODEGAS RODA SELA 2023 (V) (SP)

Spain, Rioja

Made from bush vines 15-30 years old which are low yielding but produce quality concentrated fruit. The nose is bursting with aromas of cherries, redcurrants and blackberries. The palate is elegant with lively, fresh flavours. An entire year in semi-new French oak rounds the wine out to perfection.

61. KLEIN CONSTANTIA ESTATE RED 2020 (SP)

South Africa, Constantia

Intense red and black fruit with notes of cinnamon spice on the nose. Full bodied and savoury with a well- integrated oak component, ending with a long and rich finish. The blend is dominated by king of the red grapes-Cabernet and further enhanced with Shiraz, Malbec and Petit Verdot.

62. HARDYS SHIRAZ 2022 (ALCOHOL FREE)

Australia, McLaren Vale

Very good fruit intensity of raspberries and black cherries with delicate integrated vanilla oak influence.

63. NAVARRO CORREAS RESERVE MALBEC 2021 (VE)

Argentina, Mendoza

A premium quality wine that is made from the finest quality Malbec grapes grown in Argentina. An intensely red wine with aromas and flavors of violets, plums, cherries, red fruits and black pepper. It boasts firm and round tannins, a medium-to-high body, and a very fruity character. Great balance between alcohol and freshness. This wine pairs well with grilled meats, spicy dishes, and hard cheese.
